Websites that support parents raising children with special needs

1. Website: https://tamandaotaoonline.edubit.vn/

This is an online learning website, providing courses for parents of children with developmental disorders built by experts and teachers with extensive experience in the field of education for children with developmental disorders. The website is developed and managed by Tam An Special Education Training System. This is an individual organization operating on a non-profit institute, not sponsored by any organization.

The courses not only provide knowledge for parents, but also organize training courses for parents to practice parenting and child care skills at home. Some courses are in-depth in the form of coaching, helping parents master skills after

finishing the courses. Some courses are free and some have a fee. At the end of the courses, learners are awarded a certificate of completion.

Courses are held in a combination of face-to-face and online. As for online learning content, learners can learn on any device: Smartphone, TV, computer.

2. Website: https://a365.vn/

"a365" is the abbreviation for "Ability 365". This is a website developed in the project "Application of information software in detecting and caring for children with autistic spectrum disorder", by the Center for Initiatives in Health and Population (CCIHP), Vietnam Autism Network (VAN) and domestic and international experts coordinate implementation. The project is funded by Grand Challenges Canada (main sponsor), the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and a number of other sponsors.

This website is for parents, medical staffs, teachers, and those in the field of monitoring and evaluating child development, supporting intervention, and providing educational intervention for children.

The website provides information, knowledge and measurement tools to assess and monitor children's development, screen common developmental disabilities in children (scales are classified for parents, medical staff and teachers using); provide instructional videos on organizing development activities and interventions in the areas of language, communication, and cognition for children; Providing courses to support child care skills at home and in the community, psychological support courses for parents of children with disabilities (some courses are free). Users can set up development tracking logs for each specific individual on the website (child data is managed at the source of the website).

In addition to the website format, a365 is also developed into an application running on Android and iOS operating systems. The a365 website and application can be easily accessed using a smartphone or computer connected to the internet.
